

CAN YOU **VOTE?**

LEARN THE NEW LAW

Thanks to the effort, dedication and leadership of formerly incarcerated people, their loved ones and their allies, a new law restored voting rights to people on probation and parole on March 1, 2019. Find out if YOU are eligible.

As of March 1, you **DO** have voting rights **IF:**

- You are off probation/parole by then, or
- You have been on parole for 5 years (or more) by then, or
- You have not been incarcerated on a probation violation by then

BUT YOU DO NOT HAVE TO WAIT UNTIL THE NEXT ELECTION TO REGISTER TO VOTE!



LOUISIANA HAS

- 1.7 MILLION PEOPLE WITH CRIMINAL RECORDS
- 16,000 PEOPLE RELEASED FROM PRISON EACH YEAR

WHICH MEANS

- 35,000 ON PROBATION CAN NOW VOTE
- 3,000 PEOPLE ON PAROLE CAN NOW VOTE

TO BE ABLE TO VOTE IN THE OCT. 12 ELECTION, YOU MUST REGISTER TO VOTE BY SEPTEMBER 11
